## RANGE OF PIG FEEDS

### Pig Creep Meal 22% CP

Piglets grow on the mother's milk and supplementary creep feed. For those pigs which succeed in surviving the initial few days of life, body weight doubles during each subsequent week for at least the first three weeks. This demonstrates that there is a large quantity of nutrients which need to be supplied by the milk and creep feed to the litter. Sow milk does not contain an adequate quantity of nutrients to sustain and support the rapid growth rate of a young pig beyond 21 days of age. Hyperfeeds creep meal is uniquely designed to maximize palatability for the post natal piglets to maximize growth. Under conditions of low milk production, creep feed should be provided to the litter. Normally young pigs become interested in creep feed at around 7-10 days. Feed Hyperfeeds creep meal, adlib, from around Day 7, up to Day 35, after which change over 7 days gradually to hyperfeeds Pig weaner. Average feed allowance is 0.36kg.

*Under certain production systems these two feeds can be combined in one formula called pig creep/ weaner meal which can be fed from day 7 to day 56.*

### Pig Weaner Meal 18% CP

Because of the poor feed intake and loss of body fat that occurs during the first few days of post-weaning, the nursery room temperatures should be raised slightly from temperature in the farrowing house. The nursery temperatures can be lowered subsequently as the pigs become older, heavier and accumulate more body fat. Feed Hyperfeeds Pig Weaner Meal, adlib, from Day 36 up to Day 56, after which change over 7 days gradually to Hyperfeeds pig Grower meal or hyperfeeds Pig Grower / Finisher meal

### Pig Grower Meal 16.5% CP

The grower and finisher phase has been considered to be the least complicated stage of swine production, but with newer pig genotypes and feeding strategies, It is becoming somewhat more complex. Hyperfeeds Pig Grower Meal is formulated to achieve a best cost-effective balance of all nutrients to support all nutrients to support the best possible feed conversion efficiency from your pig herd and hence improving the profitability of your operation. Feed Hyperfeeds Grower Meal, adlib, from Day 57, up to 112. After which change over gradually over 7 days to Hyperfeeds Finisher Meal. Average daily allowance is around 2.2kg

Some systems would use Pig Grower Finisher meal (16%) , from day 57 up to day 147.

### Pig Grower Concentrate 29% CP

Hyperfeeds Pig Grower concentrate is mixed at a ratio of 2 parts concentrate to 3 parts by weight milled maize to achieve pig grower/finisher meal and should be fed accordingly.



### Pig Finisher Meal 15% CP

Feed Hyperfeeds Pig Finisher, Meal, adlib from day 113, upto Day 147. This is a complete feed for slaughter as baconer or heavier. Hyperfeeds Pig Finisher meal promotes lean tissue deposition allowing for better market grades. Average daily feed allowance is around 2.4kg to 2.8kg.

### Pig Concentrate 28% CP

Mix Hyperfeeds Pig Finisher concentrate with milled maize at 2 parts concentrate to 3 parts milled by weight to get pig finisher meal and feed accordingly.

### Boar and Sow Meal 14.5%

Feed Hyperfeed Boar and Sow Meal (Breeding Stock), as follows: Boars in good condition- 1.8kg to 2kg per day. Dry sows, during the first trimester (first 12 weeks of pregnancy), should be fed between 1.8 to 2.7kg per day and 2.3 to 3kg per day for 3 weeks prior to farrowing.

### Lactating Sow 15.5%

This feed is specially designed to feed the lactating sow. At first feeding farrowing, the sow should be given only water and this feed should be increased from 2kg plus 0.45kg per piglet up to a maximum of 6.5kg by one week later.
